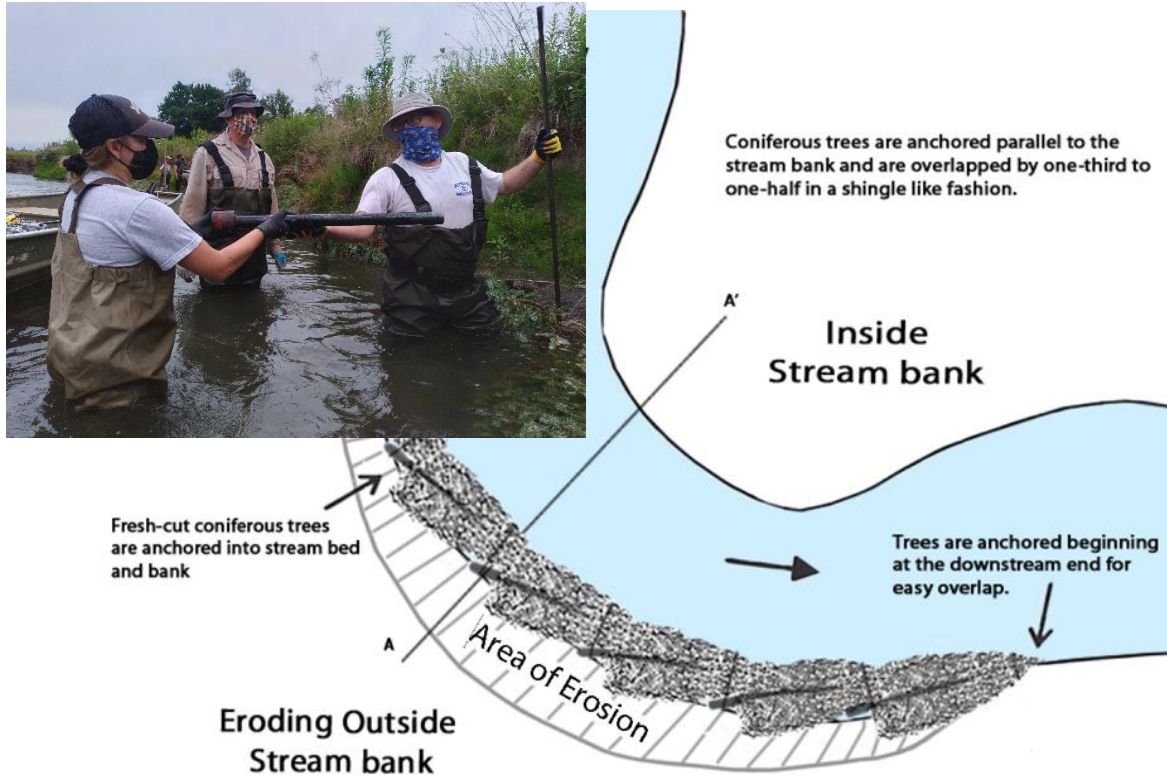


## Volunteer Opportunity to Help with Stream Restoration

The South Simcoe Streams Network and Nottawasaga Valley Conservation Authority have geared up for our summer restoration projects in the Upper Nottawasaga River located near Loretto in Adjala-Tosorontio. Much of the bank stabilization work will be done by machine, but volunteers are still needed to help with the anchoring of cut trees to the base of erosive streambanks.
